



Everything you need to know about the YEP! Schoulfoire

The Education Fair *YEP! Schoulfoire* from April 27 to April 30 2025 at Luxexpo/Luxembourg-Kirchberg is the “place to be” if you want to know everything about the school system and the professional opportunities in Luxembourg. It is also a spot to learn new and exciting things at hundreds of interactive workshops, events and presentations.

In order to make it easier for families to participate in the event, the *YEP! Schoulfoire* kicks off on Sunday already (11am to 6pm). On April 28, 29 and 30, only school classes have access to the *YEP! Schoulfoire*.

Who organises the *YEP! Schoulfoire*?

The *YEP! Schoulfoire* is organised by the Ministry of Education, Children and Youth, the Maison de l'Orientation, the Service de Coordination de la Recherche et de l'Innovation pédagogiques et technologiques (SCRIPT) and the Service de la Formation Professionnelle.

How big is the *YEP! Schoulfoire*?

The *YEP! Schoulfoire* covers an area of 17,000 m² and occupies 3 exhibition halls at Luxexpo-The Box.

Who will be at *YEP! Schoulfoire*?

A wide range of players are present at the *YEP! Schoulfoire*: public secondary schools and private establishments applying the Ministry's official curriculum; staff from the Maison de l'orientation and the Ministry of Education, Children and Youth answering questions and advising young people and their families; companies introducing themselves to young people looking for an apprenticeship as part of the *Léierplazendag* on the morning of April 28.

Who is the target audience for the *YEP! Schoulfoire*?

During school hours, the *YEP! Schoulfoire* is aimed at pupils in cycle 4 (4.1 and 4.2) of basic education and in classes 6^e and 5^e of secondary education (enseignement general & enseignement Classique) as well as the 4^e class of the "enseignement Classique". The fair is open to the public on Sunday 27 April from 11am to 6pm.

What are the opening hours of the *YEP! Schoulfoire*?

For primary and secondary schools, visits take place during school hours, between 8.30am and 15.30pm. For parents with their children and any other interested parties, the *YEP! Schoulfoire* is open on Sunday 27 April from 11 am to 6pm.

How do I get to the *YEP! Schoulfoire*?

La *YEP! Schoulfoire* is accessible by public transport (tram station “Luxexpo” or by bus (lines 18, 21, 211, 455, 811, 812). Paid parking is also available on site.

Is access guaranteed for people with reduced mobility?

Yes.

I am a parent. Do I have to register to visit the *YEP! Schoulfoire*?

Only school groups need to register in advance. All other interested parties are free to visit the *YEP! Schoulfoire* without having to register in advance. Visits to the *YEP! Schoulfoire* are entirely free of charge. The *YEP! Schoulfoire* is open to the public on Sunday 27 April from 11am to 6pm.

What is the average length of a visit to *YEP! Schoulfoire*?

Allow at least 2 hours for a visit to the *YEP! Schoulfoire*. There are plenty of activities on offer.

How long do the workshops last?

Workshops for the general public on Sunday 27 April from 11am to 6pm will last between 10 and 20 minutes. Workshops for school classes (registration required) on 28, 29 and 30 April last between 30 and 50 minutes.

Are there any catering facilities?

Food and drinks are available at the Restopolis stand. Payment methods: mycard & credit card.

When may I, as a parent, ask my questions about the education and career options available?

On Sunday 27 April from 11am to 6pm, representatives from the Ministry of Education, Children and Youth are available for all your questions in Hall 8.

How is the event being covered by the media?

During the event, photos will be taken and videos filmed. Visitors may be photographed or filmed. These recordings may be used for promotional purposes, both offline and online. For under-age pupils coming with their class, the teacher will ask the parents to sign a parental authorisation form.

You can find all the information you need at www.schoulfoire.lu. A map of the *YEP! Schoulfoire* is available to help you find your way around. QR codes on the stands lead to lots of interesting information.
